2023 Tinto Rey Rosé is a unique blend of estate fruit farmed sustainably under California Rules Certified Green. Co-fermentation of Tempranillo, Tannat and Verdejo creates the beautiful pale peach hue. The flavors are a juicy fruit bomb of strawberry, nectarine watermelon and cherry. The finish is exactly what a Rosé should be: crisp, clean, and refreshing. Pair this charming wine with fresh spring rolls, a spicy gumbo or roasted poultry.

The Story

Tinto Rey means Red King and is the name of our Spanish-centric wine brand. The Dunnigan Hills appellation is uniquely suited for grapes that thrive in a Mediterranean climate. Warm days, gravelly soil, little rainfall; these are ideal conditions for Tempranillo, Tannat, Graciano and Verdejo. The spicy, full-flavored Tinto Rey wines truly showcase the distinctive terroir of our vineyards.

The Cellar

Tinto Rey Rosé is a blend of Matchbook Estate Grown Tempranillo, Tannat and Verdejo. Our Rosé is always 100% co-fermented, meaning all three varietals were crushed and fermented together for better flavor integration. Our winemakers cold fermented (50°F) the 2023 Rosé in stainless steel tanks to preserve the just-picked fresh fruit flavors. Fermentation was arrested at .5% residual sugar to retain a touch of the natural sweetness of the grapes and add viscosity for a wonderfully crisp and refreshing wine that delivers loads of flavor.
